### *1. OBJECTIVE OF THE ASSIGNMENT*

The current call for applications targets consultants/ team of consultants with relevant experience in the field of CSO Development Effectiveness Principles, with the purpose of designing and implementing a Regional Workshop on Developing the Capacity of the CSOs from the Black Sea Region in Implementing the Development Effectiveness Principles for the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

The Regional Workshop targets CSO representatives from the Black Sea NGO Forum (in particular the CSO Sustainable Development & Corporate Working Group), from the EU and non-EU Black Sea countries and Belarus, engaged in International Development Cooperation activities.

The main topics which will be addressed during the programme will be focused on CSOs Development Effectiveness Principles, with an emphasis on Agenda 2030 and the SDGs.

The Workshop will cover 5 online sessions.

## II. RATIONALE: BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The current assignment is part of the project CPDE-SIDA Programme „Promoting the Universal Application of EDC for the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)”, implemented by the Romanian NGDO Platform – FOND.

The aim of the project is to strengthen development partnerships in Europe towards more sustainable development in Europe and beyond by strengthening CSOs capacities and effectiveness to engage in promoting Effective Development Cooperation.

There is a growing need for CSOs to improve their own accountability and development effectiveness in order to lead by examples and demand greater accountability and effectiveness from other developmental actors, especially in times of severe global social and economic crisis caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. At the same time, efforts for significantly improving their own accountability and effectiveness are also necessary for CSOs to broaden their constituency base, and respond to the trend of shrinking civic space by increasing the overall trust and support for the sector.

Between 2020-2021, in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic, non-governmental organizations from the Black Sea region (but not only) have been forced to quickly adapt their ongoing projects and redesigning their activities, in order to ensure the commitment in implementing the CSOs Development Effectiveness Principles and the SDGs.

This workshop is organized in response to the above-mentioned needs of the CSOs in the Black Sea region, and aims to build their capacity on Implementing the Development Effectiveness Principles for the SDGs.

## III. TASKS TO BE PERFORMED

The assignment of the consultant / team of consultants includes the following mandatory activities:

- Develop the programme and methodology for the Regional Workshop on Developing the Capacity of the CSOs from the EU and non-EU Black Sea countries and Belarus in Implementing the Development Effectiveness Principles for the SDGs based on input received from FOND;
- Conduct the Regional Workshop;
- Provide a toolkit with resources on the main issues addressed during the Regional Workshop, which can be disseminated to other CSOs;
- Provide an evaluation report of the Regional Workshop with recommendations to improve the programme.

## IV. DELIVERABLES

- The programme and methodology for the Regional Workshop;

- The toolkit with resources on the main issues addressed during the workshop, which can be disseminated to other CSOs;
- The evaluation report of the training with recommendations to improve the programme.

The activities and all materials will be delivered and carried out in English.

#### VII. CONTRACT

The consultant/team of consultants must be represented by a legal entity for the signing of the service contract concerning the above mentioned assignment.

#### VIII. BUDGET

The total value of the consultancy contract is \$ 5.500 USD (taxes included).

The payment will be made in tranches, based on the delivery of the following:

1. First tranche – 25% (after the final approval of the methodology);
2. Second tranche – 50% (after the finalization of the Regional Workshop);
3. Third tranche – 25% (after the delivery of the toolkit and final report).

## IX. SKILLS AND COMPETENCIES

Required:

- At least 3 years of professional experience in consultancy on CSOs Development Effectiveness Principles for the SDGs;
- Proven knowledge / experience in the field of Financing for Development and/or ODA transparency and accountability is considered an advantage;

- Excellent facilitation and training skills.
